Approval of Minutes: Tate moved, Sanger seconded, to approve the minutes of the February 6, meeting as published. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Andersen reported the club's checking account and savings account balances. Motion by Tate second by Hunter to approve report subject to audit. Motion passed.

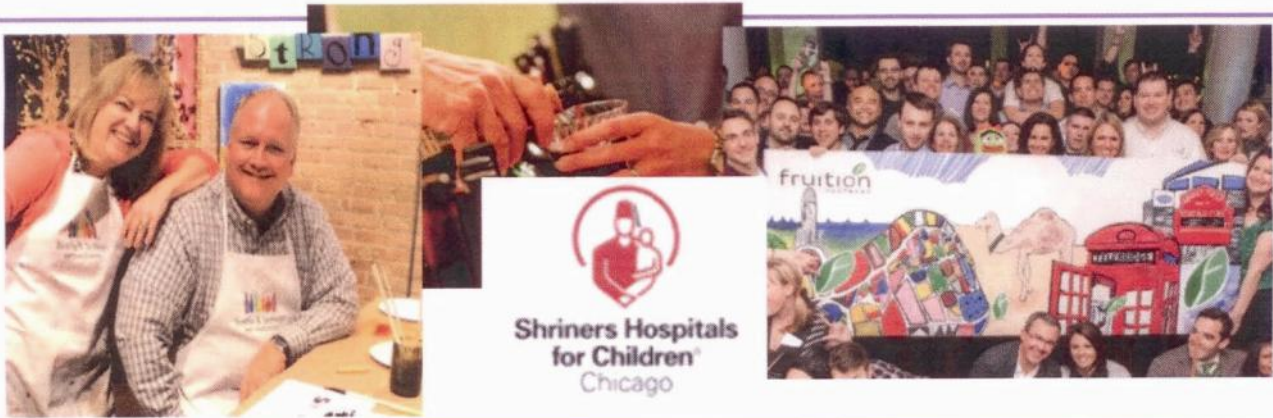
